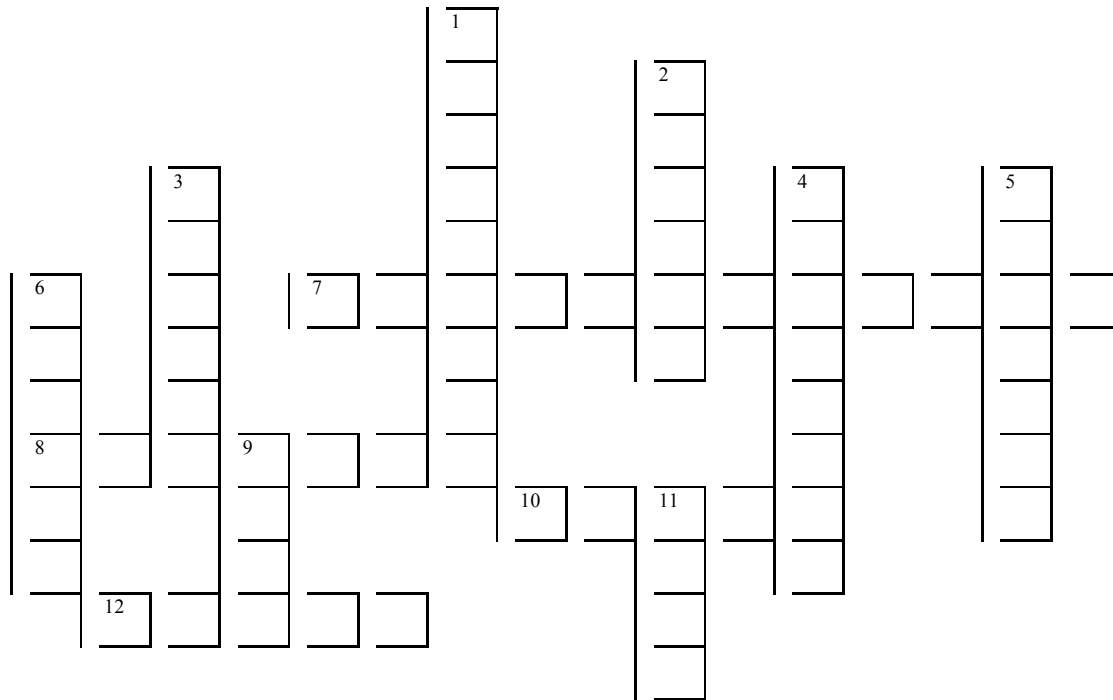


# SHIPWRECKS 1800-1945



## ACROSS

- 7 Built at Fair Island in 1924
- 8 A Rum Runner that was sunk March 22, 1929 by the US Coast Guard
- 10 Left Humbermouth on the 3rd of December 1919
- 12 Owned by Captain William Kelson Jr

## DOWN

- 1 U69, a 500 ton German
- 2 Survivors estimated at 118
- 3 Carries Viking survivors to safety
- 4 Wrecked on the rocks at Cappahayden
- 5 Edward Tolmage Bethea, passenger on the ill-fated
- 6 Lost at Great Brook, near Old Perlican, Sept 19, 1907
- 9 Went to the annual seal fishery for fifteen years and brought in a total of 170, 125 seal pelts
- 11 A thick leather dog collar, trimmed with silver and the letters on it are
